



Scrapstore

Terms and Conditions of Membership

1. Only the groups registered as members, the children and young people they serve and/or beneficiaries shall use materials/goods from the scrapstore.
2. ARRC reserves the right to refuse membership to any group not meeting the membership criteria.
3. ARRC reserves the right to prevent any member from taking materials or products that it believes would be unsuitable for their use.
4. ARRC reserves the right to limit the quantity of scrap any member may take.
5. No items taken from the Scrapstore can be used for profitable purposes or personal gain. ARRC retain the right to refuse or retract membership where the issue is questioned.
6. No items from the Scrapstore can be re-sold in any way, shape or form unless such items have been purchased rather than donated to the Member. Where items have been purchased by the Member the ownership of such items (and all relevant liabilities associated therewith) vests in the Member. If a member is found to be re-selling any items donated to it by the Scrapstore they could be liable to prosecution and ARRC reserves the right to immediately and permanently revoke membership. It is the responsibility of all members to take proper care and attention when collecting, handling, distributing and/or supervising use of any materials and products collected or purchased from the Scrapstore. Members are requested to keep all display areas tidy and report any problems to ARRC staff.
7. It is the responsibility of all Members to take proper care and attention when collecting, handling, distributing and using (and/or supervising such use) any products collected or purchased from the Scrapstore. No liability shall attach to the Council in respect of any loss or injury (of whatever nature and howsoever caused) arising from the collection, handling, distribution or use of any materials and products donated by or collected from the Scrapstore.
8. For safety reasons and consideration to others especially at busy times, ARRC does not encourage members to bring children into the Scrapstore. If children are brought in, the adults responsible for them must closely supervise them at all times. ARRC reserves the right to ask that children be taken out of the Scrapstore.
9. ARRC reserves the right to refuse membership, to alter or add to these conditions by written notice.

Membership Criteria: To become a Member you should be a creative art organisation, or carry out creative arts within your organisation. Organisations who can become Members are: Colleges; Schools; Playgroups; Nurseries; Childminders; Art Centres; Foster Carers; Nannies; Youth Groups; Sunday Schools; Community Groups; Individual Artists; art and craft students.
